MOUNT GRANT PRESERVE

San Juan Island



Located between Mount Dallas and Cady Mountain on San Juan Island, Mount Grant Preserve protects and provides access to 250 acres of diverse forest, woodlands, and meadows. Visitors to the ridgetop summit are rewarded with sweeping vistas in all directions. Trails and roadways to the summit are open daily for pedestrian and non-motorized use. Driving access to the summit is open year-round. See chart to right for days and open hours.







Directions

From the Friday Harbor Courthouse (mileage approximate):

- 0.0 Turn right on Guard St.
- 2.75 Guard Street becomes Beaverton Valley Rd.
- 3.9 Beaverton Valley Rd. becomes West Valley Rd. at intersection with Boyce Rd.
- 4.9 Turn left at Richard Lee Lane.
 Informal parking is located 400
 feet on left before the gate.

When you visit:

- Parking and entry road is on an easement. Please respect private property.
- Pedestrians, bicycles, and horses remain on designated roads and trails.
- No fires or camping.
- Dogs must be leashed.
- Seasonal deer hunting —written permission required.
- Take nothing.
- Leave nothing.
- April—September driving access to the ridgetop (weather permitting) available Wednesdays & Sundays, 10am—7pm.
- October—March driving access to the ridgetop (weather permitting) available Sundays, 10am—4pm.
